

Student Assistant Position in Neurology

We are looking for a student of biology / biomedicine or similar to support our research-enthusiastic team!

Background: Our research group for "Translational Somatosensorics" investigates the pathophysiology of pain and neuropathies in clinical and basic science projects.

We are looking for: A motivated research assistant who would like to become part of our team, supporting us with various laboratory tasks.

We offer: A team with a broad spectrum of methods, intensive training and supervision in the respective research assistance tasks, and active support.

Tasks:

- RNA isolation, cDNA synthesis and qRT-PCRs
- Induced pluripotent stem cell (iPSC) culture and cultivation of sensory neurons
- Support with cell culture work (e.g. medium change)
- Support with organizational tasks (e.g. aliquoting of reagents)

Requirements:

- Experience in cell culture / sterile work is desirable
- Experience with qRT-PCR and iPSC cultures very advantageous
- Participation in weekend services (approx. 1-2x/month, 2-3h)

Start, duration, time commitment, salary: 1.9. – 31.12.2026. The weekly time commitment is variable and flexible after training. 38 hours/month at the current standard rate of payment.
